The meridian of this survey is identical to that shown in Bk 3 of Records of Survey at Pg 128 as determined from monuments shown as found and is true North.

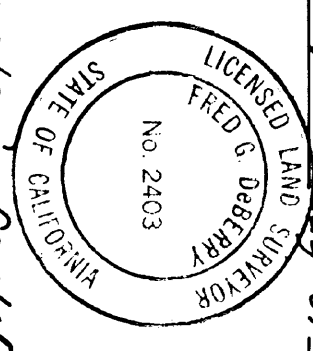

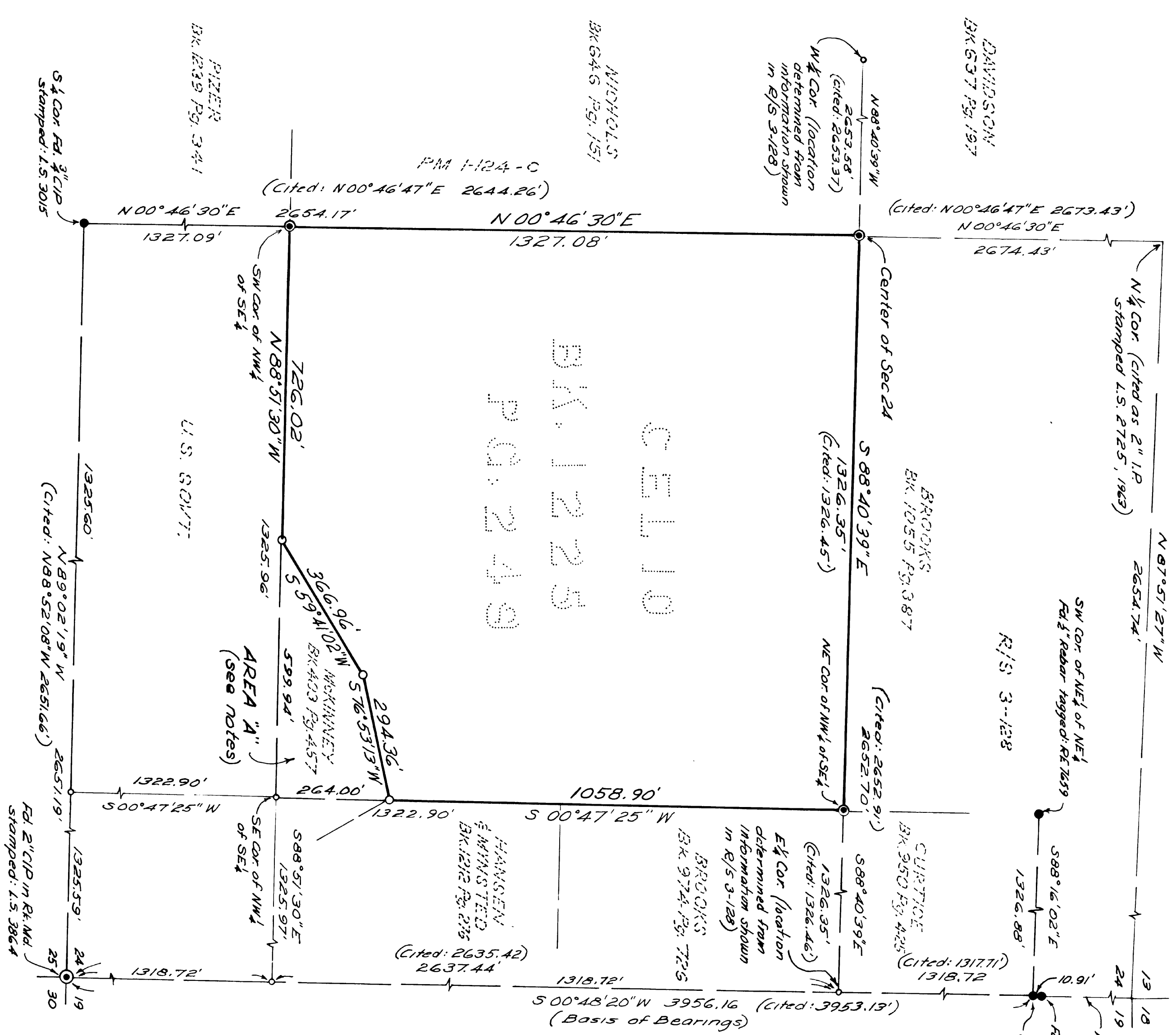
